KARST.

Karst - the land of Teran and prosciutto.

There are places in the world where the nature was especially creative when forming them. One of those is the Karst with unspoilt and unique natural and cultural heritage.



Two of the most prominent characteristics of the region (true symbols of Karst) are the famous Teran wine and the dry-cured ham — so called pršut.

Located in the south-western part of the country is defined by many visitors as one of the most beautiful corner of the world with a cuisine full of fresh, seasonal ingredients.



Both are labelled with a designation of origin and have rigid standards of production. In fact all processes of preparation, must take place on the Karst Plateau.

KARST.

The world Karst comes from the acient word karra, meaning stone.

Spectacular nature and unique colors. Karst is a unique rocky landscape, an area intertwined with more then 11.000 underground caves, disappearing lakes, wonderful wines and air cured-hams.

This 500-meter high plateau boasts itself with the greatest number of sunny days in a year in Slovenia. About 150 years ago the large part of the Karst was a naked rocky landscape.







Nowadays, the Karst surface is host to numerous species of animal and vegetation, which gives this natural region some of the most diverse flora and fauna in Europe.

Another interesting thing is that the Karst has no surface Waters, thus the porous and hydro soluble rocks are made of limestone. Karst—a stony landscape with a soft heart.

KARST. VINEYARDS









Wine is a gift of nature.

Great wine starts in the vineyard. For people living in this region, vineyard is a sacred space that demands respect, care, knowledge, love and incredible dedication.

Vineyard is also a place where nature merges their best gifts — sun, the unique terra rossa soil and karst wind.

The Karst wine-growing region extends on more than 575 hectares and is often called also the land of TERAN.

This certainly holds true, since the majority of vineyards are planted with a Refosco grape variety which, produces the TERAN wine.

KARST. VINAKRAS





The Vinakras Sežana Winnery is a cooperative. Origins date back to 1861, when a large arched cellar was made of hewed stone.

Through the years, our most important goal was focused on the production of excellent wines. The effort has finally paid off, since today Vinakras is certainly the leading producer of wines in the area of Karst.

We cultivate and ripen the majority of grapes cultivated in Karst. And we are also the worlds' major producer of Teran.

KARST. TERAN



The symbol of Karst.

Teran is a wine with centuries of history. It is essential part of Karst cultural heritage.



TERAN

is a rich, high quality red wine, full to medium-bodied, quite tannic with fresh acidity and marked aromas of forest fruits.

Vine is a gift of nature

HEALTHY WINE

Rich with antioxidant content, lactic and salicylic acid it helps reduce the risk of cardiovascular disease and anemia, lower the levels of LDL cholesterol in the blood and has beneficial effect on the digestive system and metabolism.



PTP

Teran is protected by the mark PTP (meaning Recognized Traditional Denomination) and it can be made exclusively from grapes of the variety Refosco grown on mineral-rich terra rossa soils, particularly high iron content.

IMPERIAL WINE

The story of Teran is very old at dates far back.

According to Plinius, the Roman historian, the
Roman empress Giulia, wife of Augustus,
reached a respectable age of 82 years because she
used to drink wine from Karst (known as "vino
puccinum"), particularly valued by the ancient
Greeks who called it "Praetorian wine".
